

## FAQ about RHL Preschool

### What does it mean that RHL is a NAEYC

**School?** NAEYC (National Association for the Education of Young Children) Accreditation is recognized across the country as the mark of quality education for young children. NAEYC Accreditation is the strongest system available to early childhood education programs, providing them with the tools and assistance they need to continuously improve their programs and meet NAEYC's stringent program standards.

### How can I be sure that my child's teacher is qualified to teach him/her ?

All of our teachers are CA Credentialed and follow NAEYC guidelines for teachers standards. Teachers with CA Teaching Credentials are required to complete Professional Growth hours. They achieve this by attending classes, conferences, workshops, visiting other schools and working independently on projects that interest them. This ensures that all teachers are up to date on what is happening in the field of Early Childhood Education.

### How can I be sure my child will be ready for Kindergarten?

Three times a year teachers send home progress reports to keep parents informed as to their child's progress. We partner with Chancy and Bruce Educational Resource Inc to assess children who are entering Kindergarten. We have relationships with Saddleback Unified, Capistrano Unified, and local private schools which allows us to stay up to date on Kindergarten Readiness criteria.

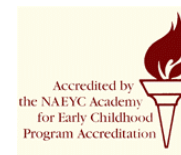

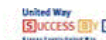

## Our history.....



- Robert H Lange preschool opened their doors on January 4, 1967.
- Robert H Lange Preschool was the first preschool in Mission Viejo.
- Has been NAEYC Accredited since 1999.
- Received a 5 star rating from the OC Department of Education "Success By 6® Star-Quality Rated Child Care Centers" (the highest rating given to a preschool in Mission Viejo).

## Our day.....

- **Chapel** – Once a week the day begins with the children singing songs, reviewing the Bible verse of the month, and hearing a short Bible story that pertains to the monthly theme. Families are welcome and encouraged to attend chapel with their child.
- **Opening Circle** -This is where the children will pick their jobs, do the calendar, weather, flag salute, and get ready to start their day.
- **Inside Time** - This is the time for children to explore all that the classroom has to offer. Each teacher designs their centers according to the theme of the month. Centers areas are: Art, Science, Dramatic Play, Reading/Listening, Manipulatives, Blocks, Sensory Table, and Writing Centers.
- **Outside Time** - There are many areas for the children to explore during outside time. Our playground includes tricycles, a giant sandbox, play dough, water table, climbing equipment, process art, and lots of room to move.
- **Snack** - Robert H Lange is a "nut free" school and adheres to the food pyramid when choosing high quality nutritious snacks. The children and teacher sit all together at the table for snack where they pour their own juice and participate in conversations.
- **Closing Circle** - The children end their day with a story or review of the day.
