Wow! The first month of 2012 has flown by quickly! But it was a fun month.

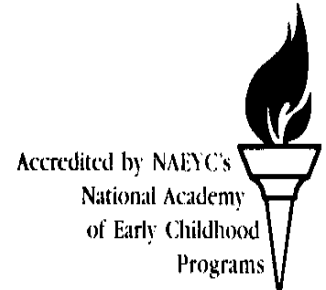
